The first question most ask after seeing this traffic-stopper is: 'Is it really edible?' Heel, yeah. The brainchild of The Les Amis Group's spunky, award-winning pastry chef Pang Kok Keong, the shoe is 100 per cent edible and made from fine dark or white Valrhona chocolate. Even the lace isn't mere icing, but painstakingly piped chocolate. As if that's not enough, the shoe cavity is stuffed with exquisitely crisp chocolate-covered caramelised almonds and wafer bits. The trick is to stuff yourself on those, then tear yourself away by putting on actual shoes. Or you could stick this into the freezer like a crazed Carrie Bradshaw and admire it forever.
