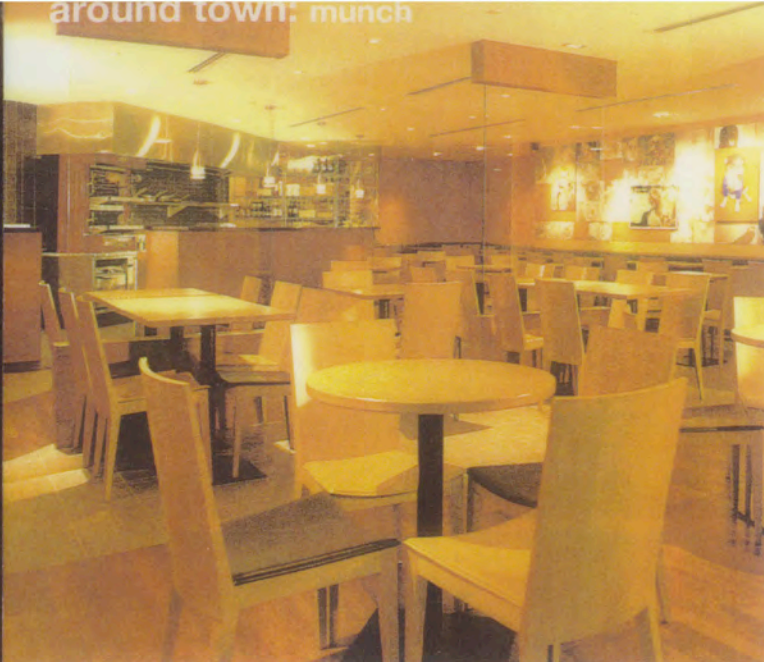

Established in March 2003 at Wheelock Place by the NYDC folks, Big O is a Café restaurant that offers an all-day dining venue with emphasis placed on serving both quality food and delicious desserts at very reasonable prices, in a casual yet chic environment. The Café restaurant showcases an open-kitchen concept, which creates a constant flow of energy and activity. In spite of the action, it remains casual and spacious, with the chairs and booth seating specially designed with the comfort of your rear in mind.

The selection of starters is a short but very sweet list of dishes that include tasty salads, fried calamari, crab cakes and the signature 'soup of the day'. The main courses are Western-oriented and focus on the rotisserie and pan-frying, with great results. For those who are all about variety and accompaniment, there is a good selection of side orders that sit very nicely alongside larger food companions.

The desserts at Big O are in a class of their own. Customers are spoiled for choice and can treat themselves to one of Big O's ice cream sundaes or special dessert creations such as the Big O Waffle served with blueberry topping, and mudslides. Also available are mudpies (ice cream cakes) such as the 'Love Bug', an irresistible combination of Macadamia Nut and Mocha Almond Fudge ice cream, and Bailey's Irish Cream soaked biscuits on a bed of Oreo cookie crust. If cheesecake is your thing, then the Big O version is a screamer. As are the chocolate hazelnut 'Indecent Obsession', and 'Fruit of the Forest', a blackforest cake, Big O style.

Aiming to make value-priced, specialty coffee accessible to everyone, McDonald's recently launched its new McCafé outlets at Shaw House Atrium and United Square. These outlets, located in the heart of the city, join existing McCafés at Great World City, East Coast Parkway and Jurong Point to give coffee-lovers an alternative place to chill out and meet up with friends, without breaking the bank for a single low fat latte.

The opening of the new McCafés coincides with the launch of an expanded menu which offers more great tasting sandwiches and salads in addition to the already wide variety of cakes and muffins. New items such as Caesar Salad, and Gourmet Cheese and Chicken Pesto sandwiches (customers can now choose from a range of specialty breads including focaccia, panini and turkish bread) will have the lunch time crowd and mid-morning snackers lined up, whilst the all-new fruity, creamy and refreshing Mango Smoothie is nothing less than sweet love in a McCup.
